RULES & PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT - JUVENILE PROGRAM

The following pertains to juveniles sentenced to the Electronic Monitoring Program in courtroom 191J. If you do not understand these rules and/or the participation agreement or if you have a situation not addressed here, ask your Electronic Monitoring Probation Officer for clarification.

PURPOSE

Electronic monitoring is an alternative sentence to jail and/or a condition of probation. This sentence provides juveniles the opportunity to attend school, court ordered programs, therapy, community service, legal and medical appointments, continue employment and live in the family home while serving the electronic monitoring sentence.

LEVEL SYSTEMS

The Electronic Monitoring Program uses 4 levels of monitoring for juveniles, depending on compliance, technology ordered and the needs of the juvenile and the juvenile's parent(s) or guardian(s). Sanctions for violations can be moving the juvenile to more intense and costly monitoring technologies or revocation of the alternative sentence and remand to jail. Juveniles may be moved to levels with increased personal time when they are in compliance.

Level I Orientation Period - No Personal Time

- The juvenile must be responsible for following the schedule set up by the Electronic Monitoring Probation Officer
- The juvenile must provide proper verification accounting for daily activities
- The juvenile must attend all court ordered meetings, electronic monitoring meetings and court ordered treatment
- The juvenile and the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must be current in monitoring fees
- After 7 days with no violations the juvenile may be moved to:

Level II Personal Time - 6 hours weekly

- The juvenile must be responsible for following the schedule set up by the Electronic Monitoring Probation Officer
- The juvenile must provide proper verification accounting for daily activities
- The juvenile must attend all court ordered meetings, electronic monitoring meetings and court ordered treatment
- The juvenile and the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must be current in monitoring fees
- After 14 days with no violations the juvenile may be moved to:

Level III Personal Time - 8 hours weekly

- The juvenile must be responsible for following the schedule set up by the Electronic Monitoring Probation Officer
- The juvenile must provide proper verification accounting for daily activities
- The juvenile must attend all court ordered meetings, electronic monitoring meetings and court ordered treatment
- The juvenile and the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must be current in monitoring fees
- After 21 days with no violations the juvenile may be moved to:

Level IV Personal Time - 10 hours weekly

- The juvenile will be allowed 10 hours per week personal time for the remainder of the sentence if all of Level III's requirements continue to be met

FEES

- There is a one-time installation fee of \$20.00 that must be paid on or before the time of hook-up.
- There is a daily charge for the equipment used that must be paid weekly in advance (see participation agreement for amount).

- If random urinalyses are ordered there will be a \$15.00 charge per test.
- If a breath analyses is ordered there will be a \$1.00 charge per test.
- Payment must be made in cash, money order or credit card. Personal checks are not accepted.

RULES

1. The juvenile must comply with all orders of the sentencing court and with all instructions of the Electronic Monitoring Probation Officer.
2. The juvenile must remain in the residence per his schedule. The only authorized reasons to leave are: to attend school, employment, court ordered appointments, meetings with the Electronic Monitoring Probation Officer and allotted personal time.
3. The juvenile must meet weekly with the Electronic Monitoring Probation Officer, bringing in necessary verification of work, school and treatment.
4. The juvenile must notify the Electronic Monitoring Probation Officer of any schedule changes (by the next working day) and bring verification of these changes to the Electronic Monitoring Probation Officer.
5. The juvenile must follow overtime work procedures.
6. The juvenile must follow procedures regarding medical emergencies.
7. The juvenile must not depart from the Denver Metropolitan area without prior authorization from the Electronic Monitoring Probation Officer.
8. The juvenile must immediately report any police contact to the Electronic Monitoring Probation Officer.
9. The juvenile must permit immediate access to the residence by police and Electronic Monitoring Probation Officers.
10. The juvenile must not use alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs.
11. The juvenile must take random urinalyses and breathe analyses as ordered by the Electronic Monitoring Probation Officer. Failure to comply with this request will result in termination from the Program.
12. The juvenile must comply with the attached equipment instructions.
13. The juvenile must not tamper with the equipment.
14. The juvenile will be liable for the cost of any equipment damaged or not returned. Criminal Mischief charges and Felony Theft charges can be filed.
15. The juvenile must follow the payment plan explained by the Electronic Monitoring Probation officer.
16. The juvenile and the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) are responsible for payment of fees and a one-time installation charge of \$20.00 (see Fees).

PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

1. I will comply with the terms and conditions ordered by the Court and the Electronic Monitoring Probation Officer. I understand that if I violate any of the terms or conditions of the Court or the Rules and Participation Agreement of the Electronic Monitoring Program, I may be terminated from the Program.
2. I am aware that if I am terminated from the Program for a violation, I will forfeit my one-week in advance payment.
3. I assume the responsibilities of the Program, the costs of the Program and the use of the equipment associated with the Program.

Please initial the following statement

_____ I, and my parent(s) or legal guardian(s), have received and read (or had read to us) the Electronic Monitoring Program Rules and Participation Agreement. We understand what we have read and all of our questions have been answered. We will comply with the Program’s Rules and Participation Agreement.

_____ I, and my parent(s) or legal guardian(s), agree to pay \$ _____ one week in advance, weekly. We understand we will have one-time fee of \$20.00 that must be paid on or before my installation date.
