APPROVED ACTIVITY LIST

- Employment with an approved Program Verification Form
- If you are self employed, you will need to provide at the time of your hookup documented proof the business is registered with the State of Colorado. (No pending or expired applications will be accepted) Additional information, such as contracts, receipts, invoices, will be required at the hookup and at each meeting while on the program.
- School to include attendance at a high school, alternative school, college or trade school. Transporting your children back and forth to school will not be approved.
- Treatment to include intake appointment, groups, UA/BAs, and antabuse
- Useful Public Service
- Medical/Dental appointments
- Court attendance/Meetings with legal counsel
- Legal/Welfare appointments
- Funerals to include parents, siblings, children, spouse, and grandparents only
- Up to three (3) hours personal business each week for clients who are on the program for sixteen (16) days or more. You will not be eligible to take this time until you have successfully completed at least one week on the program. (The time is given to attend religious services or take care of laundry, grocery shopping, paying bills, haircuts, etc.) Receipts and/or documentation will need to be provided as verification. Any program violation may result in loss of personal time.

NOTE:

You will be required to spend one day per week inside your residence.

No other activities will be approved while on the program. Arrangements will need to be made to have a family member or friend be responsible for any other activities that need to be done while on the program.

If you fail to provide the appropriate verification at the hook-up appointment, you will be placed on a lockdown schedule for one week.
