General Rules

You have been ordered by the Court to serve your sentence on electronic monitoring. You are under the supervision of the Court and the Electronic Monitoring Program (EMP). This is an alternative to a jail sentence and if you violate you will be sent back to court to serve the remainder of your time in jail. You must comply with all Court orders and the General Rules and Participation Agreement of the Electronic Monitoring Program.

RULES AND SUPERVISION

You will only be given a schedule for the activities contained in the "Approved Activities List."

You must remain **inside** your residence at all times when scheduled to be home.

You must not leave the State of Colorado without the Court's permission.

You must return to your residence daily.

You must meet with the Electronic Monitoring Probation Officer weekly.

You must provide written verification of all approved activities at your scheduled meetings.

You must not operate a motor vehicle if you do not have a valid driver's license.

You must allow law enforcement and EMP staff to make random home and employment checks to verify your whereabouts.

You must notify the program immediately of any changes in your residence or employment.

You must notify the program immediately if police contact has been made.

You must not provide false information to any program staff.

You must abide by all local, state, and federal laws.

You must not use alcohol or drugs. You must submit to breath analysis or urinalysis as ordered. You will be charged for each test.

EQUIPMENT

You understand that the Court and/or the program staff will decide the type of monitoring equipment to use.

You must comply with all instructions given regarding equipment installation and operation.

You must report any equipment concerns immediately to the program staff.

You are responsible for and must not tamper with any monitoring equipment in your possession.

You are liable for the cost of any monitoring equipment that is damaged, lost or not returned and will be charged with Felony Theft for all monitoring equipment not returned.

FEES

You are ordered by the Court and the Electronic Monitoring Program to pay all monitoring fees.

You must pay a one-time installation fee and a weekly fee based on the equipment used.

You must pay one week in advance.

You must remain current with your payment schedule.

You are aware that if you are terminated from the Program for a violation you are not entitled to a refund.

MEDICAL EMERGENCY INCIDENT PROCEDURES

If you or an immediate family member has a medical emergency, immediately contact 911 or go directly to the hospital before contacting the program. As soon as possible please contact the program and leave a message with your full name, the patient's name (if not yourself), and the hospital name and telephone number. You must provide written verification of your arrival and departure time from the hospital at your next meeting. If you are not able to return home daily, please contact the program with an update.

DOMESTIC DISPUTE INCIDENT PROCEDURES

If a domestic dispute occurs, take your monitoring equipment and immediately go to a different residence with a telephone and re-connect the equipment. If you are unable to relocate to a residence with a working phone line, you must at least plug in the electrical cord at that residence. Call the program with the new address and a contact number and remain there until you are notified by program staff. You will not be allowed to return to your residence without staff approval.

Participation Agreement

1. I have received and read (or had read to me) the Electronic Monitoring Program Rules and Participation Agreement. I understand what I have read and all of my questions have been answered.
2. I will comply with the terms and conditions ordered by the Court and the General Rules and Participation Agreement of the Electronic Monitoring Program. I understand that if I violate any of the terms and conditions of the Court or the Rules and Participation Agreement of the Electronic Monitoring Program, I will be returned to court.
3. I assume the responsibilities of the Program, the costs of the Program and the use of the equipment associated with the Program.
